



Maintenance Internship

Overview

Camp Lake Louise (CLL) is a premier Christian Camp located in beautiful Boyne Falls, Michigan. The Camp's mission and vision is to be a place where people grow, by building relationships and impacting lives in a Christ-centered environment. CLL has created a paid internship program that expands on current students' collegiate curriculum by providing on the job opportunities to lead and learn in a variety of ways. The CLL Internship is designed to develop high-caliber, collegiate men and women with a desire to focus on personal, professional and spiritual development.

Purpose

The maintenance intern should be a jack-of-all-trades. This position is critical in the upkeep of the camp and making sure that the facilities are in a quality, operating condition at all times. The maintenance intern will be very hands-on in the upkeep of the facilities at Camp Lake Louise and will be expected to know how to perform general maintenance and repairs in a variety of areas. This position is also responsible for managing resident staff at times to assist with the completion of maintenance projects.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Ensure safety of campers at all times
- Take initiative toward keeping the camp looking well-kept and operating in a quality manner
- Ensure that any repairs that need to be done are addressed and completed in a timely manner while keeping the resident director and maintenance director informed as to any major repairs or projects that need to take place
- Demonstrate appropriate physical, verbal and emotional boundaries with other staff, volunteers, and campers at all times
- Be a positive role model for campers at all times
- Attend weekly group meetings and Bible studies
- Be respectful of and get along with your co-workers, volunteer staff, and the campers
- Be open to feedback and constructive criticism from supervisor
- Read, know, and abide by the camp rules and policies provided to you and ensure that volunteers and campers adhere as well
- Be on time for job responsibilities

- Get adequate rest so that you have energy for work each day
- Meet weekly with the resident director and maintenance director
- Complete all other tasks, necessary to the function of the camp, as assigned by supervisory staff
- Assist with cleanliness of the cabins, buildings, and outdoor experience of Camp Lake Louise

Minimum Requirements

- A Growing Christian
- Willingness to work with children and teenagers
- Must be capable of passing required background checks
- Be able to work with others cooperatively and creatively
- Be in good health and able to participate in strenuous activities
- Be flexible and willing to support the overall life and ministry that occurs at camp
- A general working knowledge of basic carpentry, rudimentary electrical & plumbing as well as general mechanical maintenance
